**Note:** your witnesses must be over 18 years of age, and must not be visually impaired. They should also not be beneficiaries in the Will.

Once witnessed, your Will is valid and remains in place until your death, or until you choose to update it. Fortunately, changing your Will is just as easy as creating it.

Creating your Will online means it's easy to change and update it as often as you like. And, being a free service, you don't need to pay out to do it.

**Wills101** is **free** to use, but it is important to remember that, if you chose to, you will need to pay for a solicitor or trustee to hold the copy of your Will for safekeeping, witness it, act as your executor or give you legal advice. However, none of this is required by law.
